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GST is considered to be India's most ambitious tax reform and the Government of ${}^{{f in}}$ the say has made much progress this year towards ushering in the GST regime (http (https://www.thedollarbusiness.com/news/gst-council-agrees-on-five-areas-set- mini= to-meet-again-this-month/48119) The Constitution (One Hundred and Twenty-most-Second Amendment) Bill, 2014 was passed by the Rajya Sabha on 3rd Augustambi 2016 and by the Lok Sabha on 8th August 2016. Soon after, the Bill was ratified axby the States with 2/3rds majority, and received Presidential assent on Septemberrefori 9th, 2016, to be enacted as the Constitution (One Hundred and First Amendment)stean Act, 2016 ("Amendment Act"). The provisions of the Amendment Act were notified hear in September 2016, which immediately raised certain issues as to themost Government's present power to levy duties, taxes. The Finance Ministry cleared mbi the air on this aspect, and the focus on all matters GST shifted to the GST Councitax ("GSTC"), which has been formed in terms of Article 279A of the Constitution. The effort Finance Minister is the Chairman, the Revenue Secretary (Ministry of Finance) has teah been appointed as the ex-officio Secretary to GSTC, and the Central Board of head Excise and Customs Chairperson has been included as permanent invitee (nontaxvoting) to all GSTC proceedings. Finance (Revenue) Ministers of all Indian States refori (or other ministers nominated) are members of the GSTC as well. stean

Per the Amendment Act, the GSTC is entrusted with the power to recommend the head threshold limits, rates of GST, list of exempted supplies, apportionment of GST on **f** inter-State supplies, principles governing place of supply, etc.

The GSTC has till date held two meetings. During its first meeting on (22nd to 23rd **G**+ September), consensus was reached on some issues including: (i) threshold limit(http: (of Rs 10. lakhs for assessees in North-Eastern States, and other hill States, and url=h most

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Rs. 20 lakhs for all other States), (ii) the subsumption of all cesses presently mbit levied (such as Education Cesses, SwachKHBTHBFatWebssTetter, PWAtHBHStNESGSTMO DELAxlevied. For VAT registered assessees with a turnover of above Rs. 1.5 http crores, a system of cross empowerment between States and Centre was agreed on. Further, for service tax assessees, it was agreed that State Government most officials would have to be trained in due course to handle the service tax matters and until such time, the Central Government would have exclusive jurisdictional taxcontrol over all service tax assessees (irrespective of their turnover). refori

During the second meeting of the GSTC (on 30th September), the draft GST rulestean (https://www.thedollarbusiness.com/news/gst-council-agrees-on-five-areas-set- ahead to-meet-again-this-month/48119) on the invoice, registration, return, notificationmost and payment which were released for public comments were approved by the mbi GSTC. These rules will be notified after the enactment of the GST Acttax Unfortunately, in the course of discussions, the division of administrative control effort over assessees, between the Centre and the State on which consensus wastean previously reached, turned out to be a thorny issue, and the consensus on this topic broke down. States have requested for better clarity regarding control of taxservice tax assessees in sectors where both goods and services are involved, such refori as in construction. A technical committee of officers has now been set up to examine these issues; this committee will hold meetings, including one in the week commencing 3rd October in Ahmedabad, to later brief their respective State f Finance Ministers.

In the third meeting of the GSTC, scheduled to take place from 18th to 21st u=hti October, the GSTC is to select the Vice-chairman of the GSTC (from one of the State's Ministers) and discuss the formula for calculating compensation for States, ambii and rates for GST. Pertinently, the Reserve Bank of India in its Monetary Policy, Report mentioned that an 18% GST rate would not have a material impact on the inflation. It now has to be seen what the GSTC fixes up as its recommendation as to rates.

Thereafter, in November 2016, the GSTC will finalize the draft Model GST laws, **G**+ and also finalize the crucial GST rates and the list of exempted goods and (http: services. url=r
