

## EOGM vide OVAM can be held till September 30, 2020 instead of June 30, 2020

As you are aware, the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) had vide General Circular dated April 8, 2020 (<u>available here</u>) and April 13, 2020 (<u>available here</u>) (collectively, **Original Circulars**), allowed for conducting of extraordinary general meeting (**EGM**), to be held on or before June 30, 2020, through video conferencing or other audio-visual means.

In continuation of the aforementioned, MCA has vide General Circular No. 22/2020 dated June 15, 2020 (<u>available here</u>) extended the time period of application of the relaxation under the Original Circulars from June 30, 2020 to September 30, 2020.
