

## BIS Update: Mandatory Certification Requirements for Steel and Steel Products

Dear Reader,

We are writing to you with an important update regarding mandatory registration requirements applicable to imports of **steel and steel products** into India.

Background	The Government of India has on 5 <sup>th</sup> February 5, 2024, notified the Steel and Steel Products (Control) Order, 2024. This order expands the scope of the existing Steel and Steel Products (Control) Order, 2020 by adding additional products. The relevant link is available <a href="here">here</a> . 	To obtain such license, both foreign producers and domestic manufacturers of these products we need to submit an application to the BIS seeking certification. Furthermore, the process of certification will also require physical testing and inspection of the relevant product at the factory premises as we as parallel testing by a BIS authorized laboratory in India to verify the same. BIS certification is a till consuming process and therefore it is recommended that interested producers make applications certification at the earliest in cases wherein Quality Control Orders have been issued and are pendenforcement.
